Peer Review Policy

AHABA-JOCA is dedicated to producing high-quality scientific publications with both local and global relevance. To achieve this, all submissions are subjected to a rigorous double-blind peer review process. Simultaneous submissions to multiple journals are strictly prohibited, and manuscripts falling outside the journal's scope will be rejected. Each paper is evaluated by at least two experts recommended by the editorial board, with editors retaining the option to seek additional reviews when necessary. The Editors-in-Chief make all publication decisions based on the referees' reports, and authors are promptly informed of acceptance or rejection. All manuscripts are treated as confidential, and reviewers are expected to maintain confidentiality and disclose any conflicts of interest. The peer review process is confidential, and reviewer identities are protected
